Chancellor's Profile

Sri. G M Lingaraju Chancellor

A Visionary Leader, Industrialist, and Nation-Builder

Sri G.M. Lingaraju is a distinguished industrialist, educationist, philanthropist, and visionary leader whose contributions span industry, agriculture, education, and social development. Born on 15 August 1968 in Chitradurga, Karnataka, he comes from a family deeply rooted in public service. He is the son of Late Shri G. Mallikarjunappa, a respected agriculturist, industrialist, and former Member of Parliament, and the younger brother of Sri G.M. Siddeshwara, a four-term Member of Parliament. These influences shaped his lifelong commitment to integrity, leadership, and nation-building. He completed his schooling at Janaseva Vidya Kendra, Channenahalli, Bengaluru, and earned a Bachelor of Commerce degree from Government College, Chitradurga. A disciplined individual with a passion for sports, he actively participated in basketball, swimming, and hockey, reflecting the perseverance and teamwork that define his leadership style.

As Chairman of the GM Group of Companies, Sri G.M. Lingaraju has played a significant role in Karnataka's industrial growth. The group's diversified presence across education, manufacturing, power generation, healthcare, real estate, exports, and social welfare has achieved a consolidated turnover exceeding ₹18,000 million and created employment for more than 5,300 people. His leadership has been instrumental in revitalizing industries and fostering sustainable economic development.

A notable achievement under his stewardship is the transformation of GM Sugar and Energy Ltd. into a modern and efficient enterprise with a crushing capacity of 5,000 TCD and power generation of 18 MW supplied to the national grid. His investments in ethanol production and cogeneration have strengthened rural economies, generated over 2,000 jobs, and enhanced farmer livelihoods through sustainable agricultural practices.

Deeply connected to agriculture, Sri G.M. Lingaraju has championed farmer empowerment through financial inclusion and technological support. Initiatives such as the GM Souharda Pattina Sahakari Niyamita Co-operative Bank have enabled sugarcane and arecanut farmers to access credit and modern farming solutions, contributing to rural prosperity.

Education remains central to his vision. As Secretary of the Srishyla Educational Trust, he has nurtured institutions including GM Institute of Technology, GMH Pre-University College, and GM Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research. This legacy culminated in the establishment of GM University, Davanagere, in 2023, envisioned as a hub of academic excellence, innovation, and industry collaboration, with a strong focus on empowering rural youth.

His philanthropic work through the G. Mallikarjunappa – Smt. Halamma Charity Foundation encompasses healthcare support, scholarships, clean drinking water initiatives, and large-scale job fairs benefiting thousands of students. As an active member of FICCI and CII, he also contributes to policy advocacy and national economic development.

As Chancellor of GM University, Sri G.M. Lingaraju exemplifies visionary leadership, social responsibility, and an enduring commitment to education and national progress.



Chief Guest's Profile

Dr. Mylswamy Annadurai

Renowned Space Scientist,
Former Director of ISRO Satellite Centre

Dr. Mylswamy Annadurai, widely celebrated as the “Moon Man of India,” is one of the country’s most distinguished space scientists whose contributions have profoundly shaped India’s space programme. Born in Kodhawady village in Coimbatore district, he completed his schooling locally before obtaining his B.E. from the Government College of Technology, Coimbatore, and his M.E. from PSG College of Technology. In 1982, he joined the Indian Space Research Organisation, beginning an illustrious career that spanned more than three decades. Early in his tenure, he served as Team Leader for the Software Satellite Simulator, and subsequently as Spacecraft Operations Manager for IRS-1A and INSAT-2A. His expertise in satellite and mission management led him to serve as Mission Director for several key national missions, including INSAT-2C, INSAT-2D, INSAT-2E, INSAT-3B, GSAT-1 and INSAT-3E. He played a historic role as Project Director of Chandrayaan-1 and contributed significantly to Chandrayaan-2, later serving as Programme Director for Indian Remote Sensing, Small, Science and Student Satellites. From 2015 to 2018, he led the U. R. Rao Satellite Centre, Bengaluru, as its Director, steering the development of multiple advanced satellites across communication, navigation and earth observation.

He is a Trustee Member of the American India Foundation Trust, Director of SSI Innovations in New Delhi and SS Innovations International Inc. in Florida, Advisor to Daksha Unmanned Systems and Executive President of the Senior Citizens Support Forum, Chennai. In 2025, he assumed leadership as Chairman of HONC Gas Pte Ltd, Singapore.

Dr. Annadurai’s remarkable contributions have earned him numerous national, international and institutional honours. These include the Padma Shri (2016), Karnataka Rajyotsava Prashasti (2008), multiple honorary doctorates, and distinguished alumni recognitions from premier institutions. ISRO has honoured him with the Vikram Sarabhai Research Award, ISRO Merit Award, Team Excellence Awards and the Outstanding Achievement Award. Professional bodies across the world have recognized him with awards from the International Academy of Astronautics, American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, Aeronautical Society of India, NIQR, and several global scientific forums. Social and public institutions have also honoured him with awards for human excellence, science promotion, leadership and lifetime contributions.

A visionary scientist and an inspiring leader, Dr. Annadurai continues to be a guiding force for young innovators and a respected voice in India’s scientific community.
